The Professionals' Advisory Council will hold its annual Spring Exhibit in Gould Court from May 8 - 24, 2009.

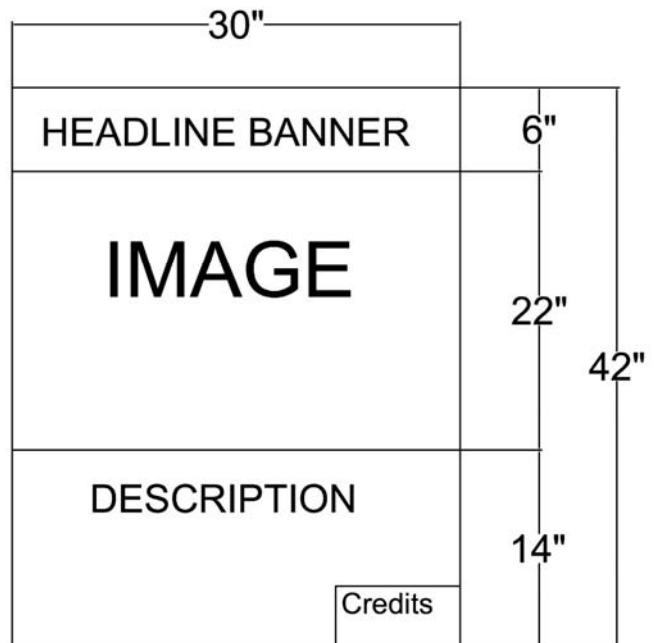

**PRESENTATION MATERIALS**

- **Each board and model will present one project.**
- **SIZE:** Exhibited work will be vertically mounted on 42"x30"x1/2" board of a corrugated cardboard product
- **LAYOUT: (See Diagram)**
  - (1) Top 6" x 30" -- HEADLINE  
Key Design Idea (not the project name)
  - (2) Middle 22" x 30" -- IMAGE  
Graphic Image of the Key Idea
  - (3) Bottom 14"x 30" – DESCRIPTION  
Communication to support Idea and Image
- **CREDITS:** On the front of the board in the bottom right corner include the project name, location, name of architect/team and each architect's university education (school, name of degree and year of graduation).
- **MODELS:** Project models are encouraged with a pedestal base provided by the entrant . Preferred size is no larger than width of exhibit board, but accommodations may be made for larger models at the discretion of event administrators. Participants must bring in and display models on the first day of exhibit, and collect models on the last day. Models are displayed at entrants own risk.
- **LABELS:** On the back of the exhibit board and on the bottom of the model, please adhere a copy of the previously mailed entry form.

- The Council reserves the right to refuse a submission if it does not comply with Spring Exhibit 2008 conditions or is considered inappropriate.
- Digital images of exhibit entries will be published on the Department of Architecture website. If you wish to have your work included, please provide an 8-1/2” x 11” PDF of your entry taped to the back of the exhibit board. Include the name of project, location and a business card for the contact architect, on the inside of the jewel case cover.
- Deliver boards to Department of Architecture Gould Hall Room 208, 3949 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE, Seattle, WA, 98195. For exhibit board/model drop-off and pick-up, use on-street parking (building loading dock is a violation area).
